“Creating Peace”

Every day we encounter different forms of conflict. People don't always agree but at the end of the day we work to understand each other, find peaceful solutions, and make changes that leave the world better than we found it. Collaborate with your classmates to create a short film about how overcoming and resolving a conflict creates a positive change.

Requirements

- Think about the people involved in the dispute and how they resolved their differences. This could be people you know, historical figures, characters from a favorite book, or original creations.
- Consider how to **present your story**: chronological order, through a narrator, and/or flashbacks?
- Structure your film so **the audience understands** who the characters are and what the story is about.
- **Get creative** with sets, costumes, sound, and/or special effects to enhance your film.
- Incorporate an **object associated with peace** (e.g., peace sign, dove, olive branch, etc.).

Rules

- **Work together** to share ideas, film your story, and make edits.
- All films must be **original** works created by your team.
- Maximum running time for your film is **2 minutes** including credits— no exceptions, not even a split screen second.
