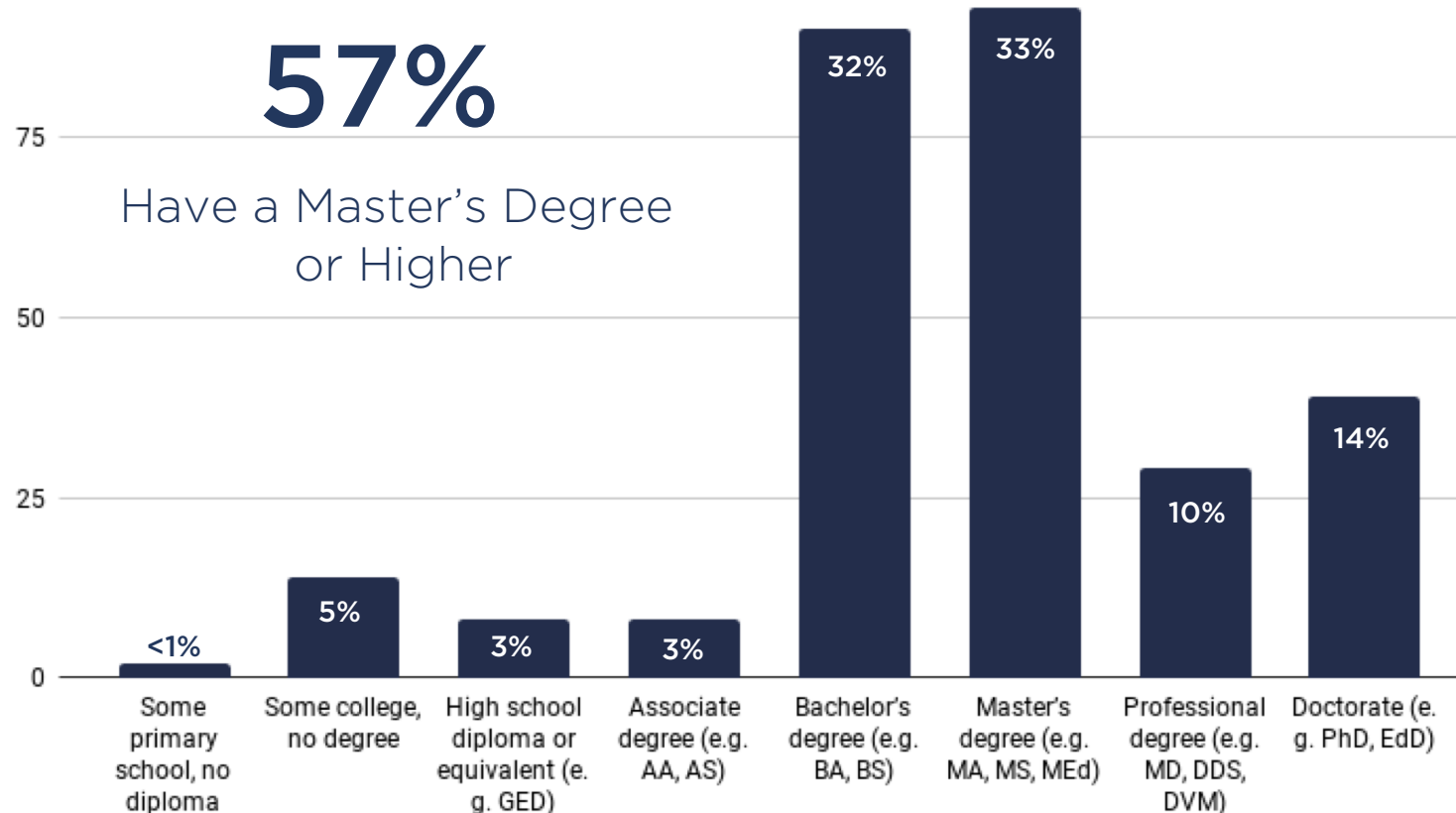
- **67%** are residents of Charlottesville City and Albemarle County

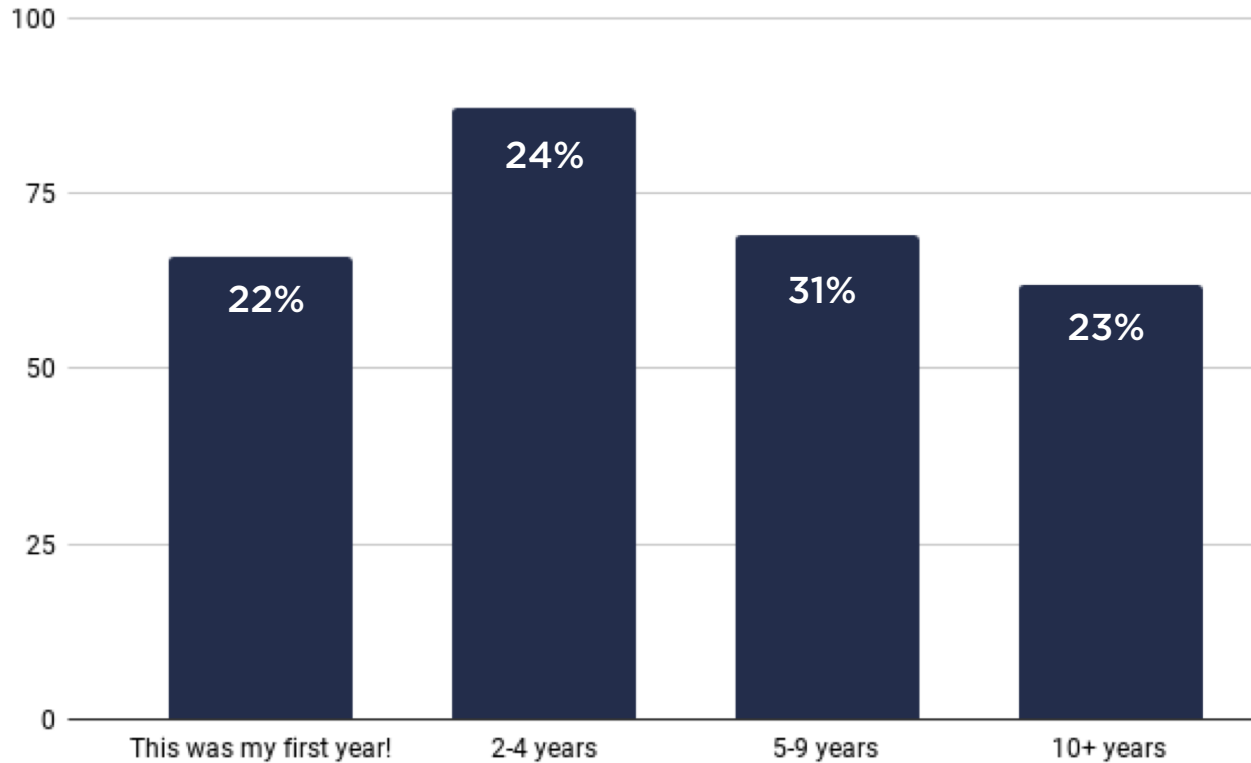

## Degree Representation

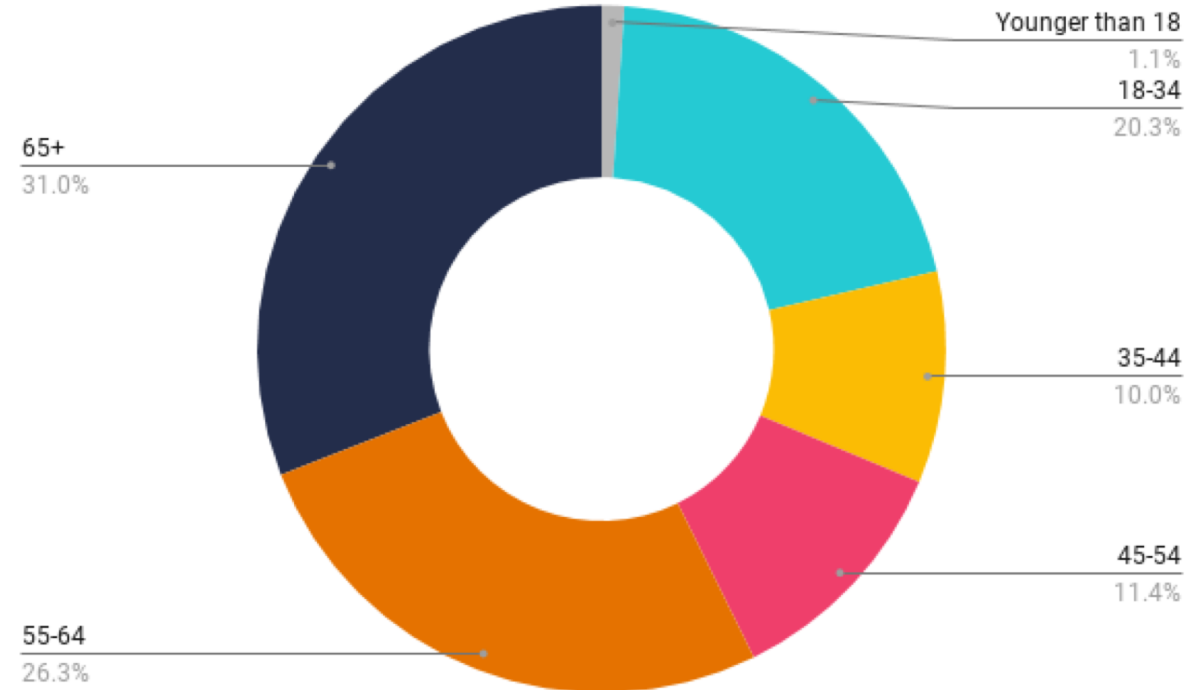

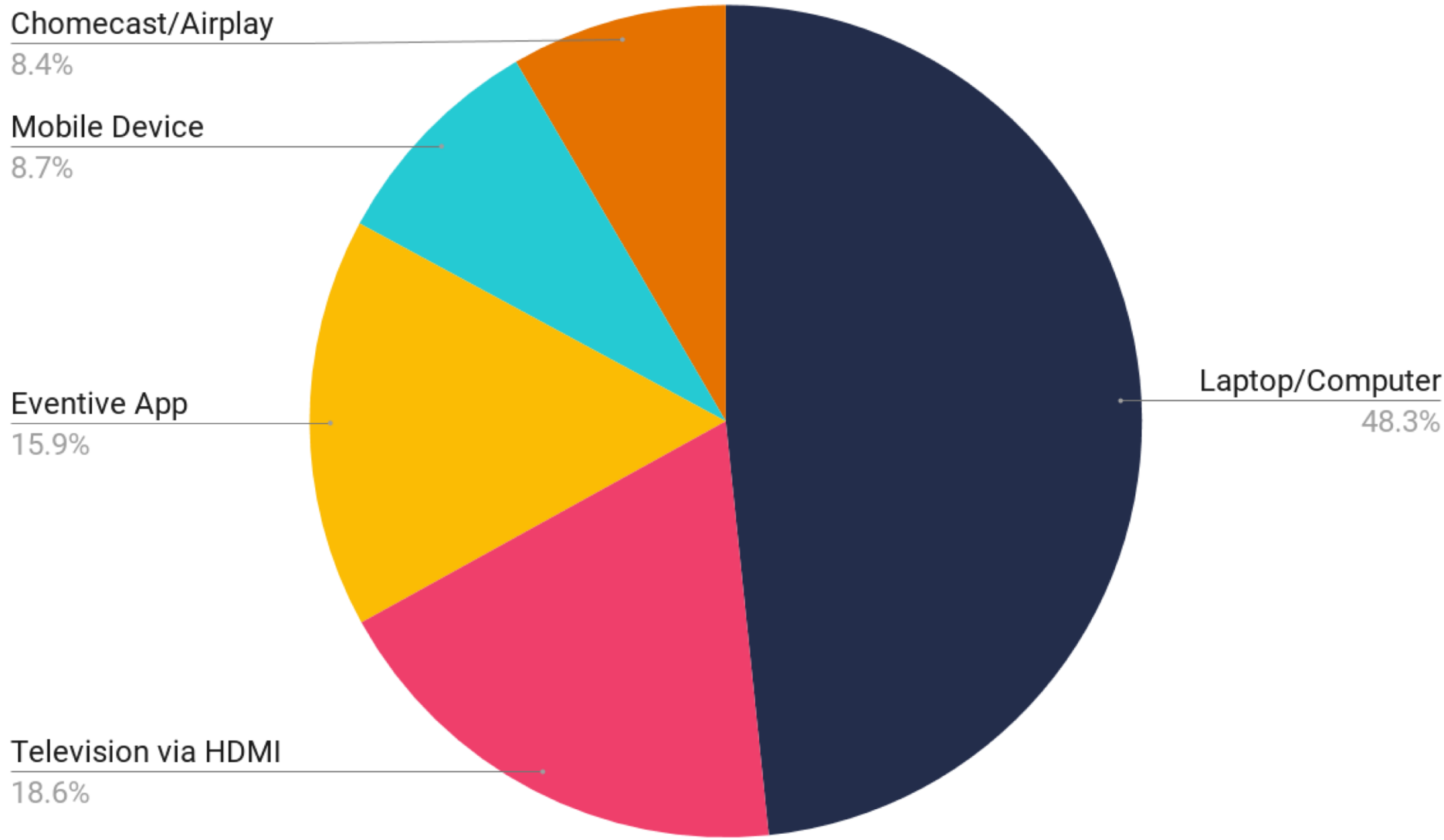
